Merlot - Don Segundo, Chile: Rich fruit flavours of blackberries and forest fruits that blend with touches of spices and chocolate. 175ml - £4.20 250ml - £5.50 Bottle - £16.50

Cabernet Sauvignon - Don Segundo, Chile: Notes of bright red fruit and cassis, a juicy and fruit-forward wine with medium body and smooth tannins. 175ml - £4.20 250ml - £5.50 Bottle - £16.50

White Zinfandel - Hunters Cove, South Africa: Light and refreshing with hints of summer fruits. 175ml - £4.30 250ml - £5.85 Bottle - £17.50

Chardonnay - Don Segundo, Chile: Aromas include mature banana, pineapple and subtle notes of toasted almonds & chestnuts. 175ml - £4.20 250ml - £5.50 Bottle - £16.50

Sauvignon Blanc - Don Segundo, Chile: Notes of zesty lemon and grapefruit and a touch of fresh herbs. 175ml - £4.30 250ml - £5.85 Bottle - £17.50

Pinot Grigio - Trulli, Italy: Flowery young aromas and delicious hints of spice. Dry and crisp with good fruit flavours.

Trulli Prosecco, Italy: Packed with soft fruit flavours, hints of peachy fruit and a long lingering finish. 125ml: £4.95 Bottle: £22.00

Malt Whisky (25ml) £4.75

Island (known for both feathery citrus flavours and smoking peaty noses)

Highland Park 12 year old – Syrup sweetness, creamy wood, pineapple and smoked orange rind

Tallisker 10 year old – Dried fruit sweetness, strong barley-malt flavours, peppery

Jura 10 year old – Rich and rounded, milk chocolate raisins, soft peat smoke

Islay (known for being pungent with peat and smoke)

Ardbeg 10 year old – sea spray. Tarry rope, immense smoky intensity

Bowmore – Peat smoke with hints of citrus and vanilla

Bruichladdich - The Classic Laddie - ripe green fruit, brown sugar and sweet malt

Bunnahabhain 12 year old – toasted nuts with vanilla and an aroma of dried fruits

Laphroaig 10 year old – malted barley, rich and smoky

Speyside (known for being frugal with peat and lavish with nutty fruit flavours)

Aberlour 10 year old – subtle aromas of spice with hints of autumn fruits

Balvenie Double Wood 12 year old – complex yet rich and smooth with fruity, honeyed depths

Glenfiddich – balanced nose and refreshingly complex flavour

Glenlivet Reserve – sweet, fruit notes of zesty oranges and pears

Highland (known for its variety)

Ben Nevis 10 year old – hints of vanilla, butterscotch and toffee with a medium finish

Dalwhinnie 15 year old – smooth, aromatic flavour with heather honey sweetness

Glen Morangie 10 year old – honeyed sweetness with notes of citrus, almonds and creamy vanilla

Macallen Gold – citrus and boiled sweets with hints of ginger and cinnamon

Oban 14 year old – notes of citrus with smooth sweetness

Old Pultney 12 year old – chocolate, peanut with mint and citrus peels

Lowland – (known for soft and smooth malts)

Glenkinchie 12 year old – açachia honey, notes of madeira and sweet stewed fruit
